Class Descriptions

Beginners

This session emphasizes the development of basic strokes and mini-tennis play for players ages 6 - 10. The class for 11-18 year olds will emphasize the development of basic strokes, scoring, singles game play and singles tournament play.

Advanced Beginners

This session will emphasize the development of basic strokes, scoring, singles game play, and singles tournament play. This level of lessons is designated for players under 12 who have completed the Beginners class for 6 - 10 year olds or previous experience.

Intermediates

This session emphasizes the continued development of the basic strokes, singles strategy, and singles game and tournament play. This level of lessons is designed for those who have done well in Beginners and/or Adv. Beginners. This session is also for those who have good form and are ready for full court game play.

Advanced Intermediates

This session emphasizes the continued development of all strokes, singles and doubles strategy, and singles and doubles game and tournament play. This is for players who have good form and have done well in Intermediates. This session is also for those who would like to continue their development of singles game play and begin to develop doubles play.

Advanced 1 - 5

Our Advanced sessions will emphasize the continued development of all strokes, singles and doubles strategy and game play and tournament play. These advanced lessons will prepare the tennis player for recreational, middle school, senior high and collegiate competition.

Adult Tennis Lessons

The Adult tennis lessons emphasize the development and continual development of the basic strokes and strategies for singles and doubles game play. Special emphasis will be placed on doubles play.
